




BOTIUQE HOTEL

Lumière Cotton is a boutique hotel located in the heart of Tel Aviv, offering a soft and serene escape within the vibrant city. The design concept, "Cotton in the Light," draws inspiration from the delicate interaction between natural light and soft textures.

The project celebrates the essence of tranquility, combining the purity and comfort of cotton with the gentle play of light to create a soothing atmosphere. Natural materials such as travertine stone, walnut wood, brushed aluminum, and linen-like textures enhance the sense of calm and warmth.

Designed as an adults-only retreat for couples, the hotel invites guests to slow down and reconnect through a sensory experience that merges minimalism, elegance, and comfort. Every element—from the material palette to the lighting—reflects a refined balance between softness, nature, and urban sophistication.

INDUSTRIAL PROJECT AT UNIVERSITY

The ground floor functions as the art gallery, celebrating finished works, while the upper level houses the creative studios and workshops. The mix of natural textures, checkerboard stone floors, and warm oak wood creates a refined yet welcoming environment.



HOUSING PROJECT AT UNIVERSITY



Natural materials play a central role: travertine stone clads the fireplace wall as a focal point, oak wood is used for doors, stairs, and butcher-block details, and porcelain flooring adds durability with a refined finish. The palette of earthy tones, muted colors, and warm metallic accents ties the spaces together harmoniously.

The layout preserves the home's functionality while refreshing its interiors to create inviting shared spaces on the ground floor and cozy private rooms upstairs. Soft lighting, tactile textures, and thoughtful detailing transform the house into a peaceful sanctuary that supports family life with style and comfort.
